1 Introduction

This document is to be read in conjunction with the **SMS GupShup Enterprise** document.

Mobile access will allow you to access your groups through the specified mobile phone(s). You can create new groups too through the specified mobile phone(s).

2 Enabling Mobile Access via website

Log into your account on <http://enterprise.smsgupshup.com>.

After logging in, click on the *Groups* tab. Click on the 'group settings' tab for the group for which you want to enable mobile access.

Check the 'enable' option.

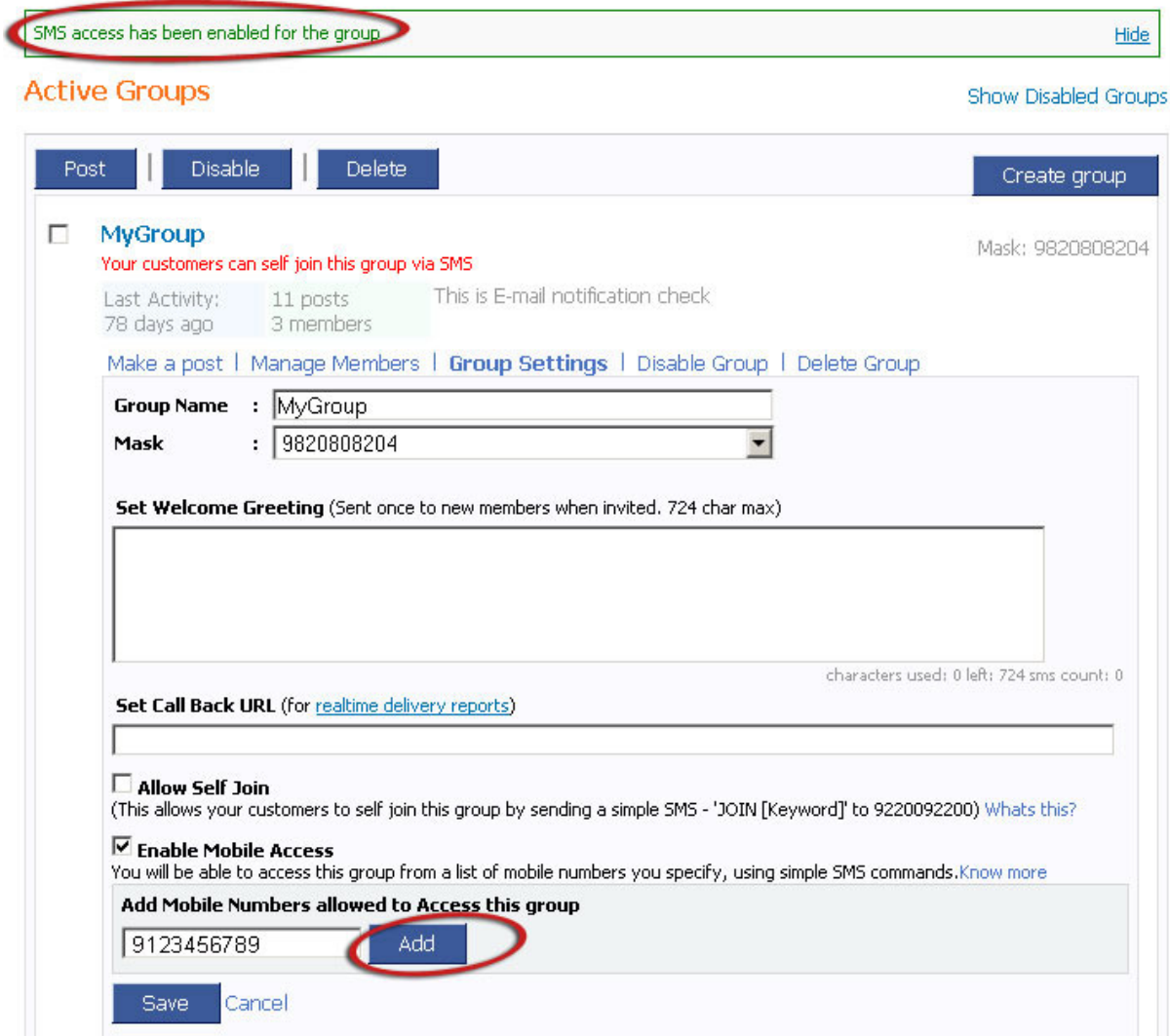

2.1 Mobile access for group creation.

You can now create groups through the mobile phone. To enable this feature, click on Settings on the top bar.

Check 'Advanced Settings' option on this page. Check the 'enable' option for group creation by SMS. Add the mobile number on which you want provide this feature. You can add upto 7 different mobile numbers which will be able to create groups under your account.

Advanced Account Settings

Enable Group Creation by SMS

This will enable you to create Groups by using simple SMS commands from phone numbers individually via the checkbox in the group settings tab. SMS 'CREATE' followed by the group name eg SMS **CREATE MyGroup** will create a group with name 'MyGroup'.

3 SMS Access

Once mobile access is enabled for a particular group, the following actions can be performed –

1. Post on the group
2. List groups
3. Create new group
4. Add numbers to a group
5. Delete numbers from a group
6. List masks valid for a group
7. Post a message to an individual number
8. Post a message to multiple numbers

NOTE: All SMS commands through the mobile phone must be sent to [567678080](tel:567678080) or [9220092200](tel:9220092200)

3.1 Post to a group

To post on the group, SMS POST <space> GROUPNAME <space> MESSAGE to 567678080 or 9220092200



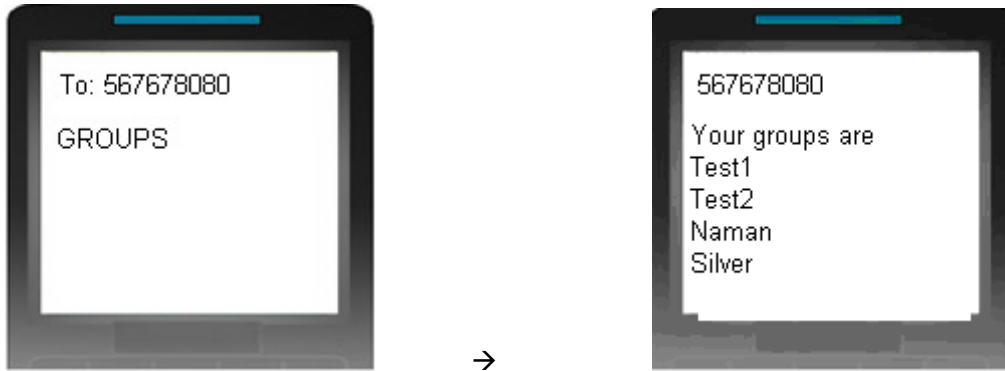

NOTE: If you are posting using a CDMA mobile phones (Reliance/TATA) the maximum length of message is 135 characters. If you are posting via GSM mobile phones maximum length is 300 characters.

3.2 List groups

This will enable you to see all enabled groups for your mobile number under your account. To see the list, SMS GROUPS to 567678080 or 9220092200

3.3 Create new group

If group creation is enabled for your mobile number, you can create a group by sending CREATE <space> GROUPNAME <space> MASK to 567678080 or 9220092200

3.4 Add numbers to a group

You can add mobile numbers to a group to which you have mobile access, by sending ADD <space> GROUPNAME <space> Number1 <space> Number2 <space>..... NumberN to 567678080 or 9220092200. Please note that the mobile numbers must be Indian.

3.5 Delete numbers from a group

You can delete mobile numbers from a group to which you have mobile access, by sending DEL <space> GROUPNAME <space> Number1 <space> Number2 <space>NumberN to 567678080 or 9220092200

3.6 List masks valid for a group

You can see all valid masks for groups enabled on your mobile phone by sending MASKS to 567678080 or 9220092200

3.7 Post a message to an individual number

You can post a message to a single number by sending POST <space> NUMBER <space> MESSAGE to 567678080 or 9220092200

3.8 Post a message to multiple numbers

You can post a message to multiple numbers by sending POST <space> Number1 <space> Number2 <space> NumberN <space> Message to 567678080 or 9220092200
